On October 6, 1927, the first "talkie" premiered and changed film forever. The film's star was Al Jolson, known as the World's Greatest Entertainer. To celebrate 80 years of revolutionary entertainment, The Jazz Singer will be shown in a new digital restoration at the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences, followed by two days of Jolson films, a screening of the rare Vitaphone short short "Al Jolson in A Plantation Act" which was produced in 1926. 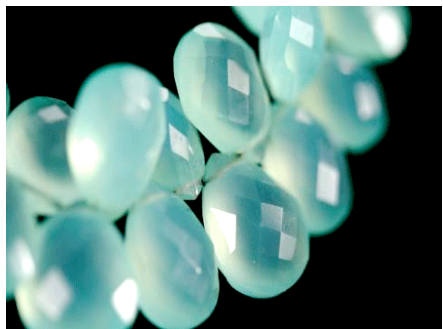

Think... Grindhouse Meets John Ford



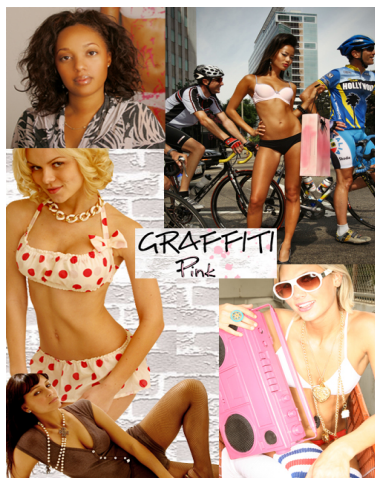
